



Executive Committee Meeting Minutes
Virtual Zoom Meeting | Thursday, 06.18.20 | 5:30pm

Call to Order: *(there was no official agenda)*

Meeting began 5:45pm with Mr. Christian informing the group that as of right now, Texas students will be returning to school in person this fall, as per a statement from Gov. Greg Abbott. He also inquired about the firework store about advertising and how the various shifts would work. He was informed that MCHS band advertise on our website and social media accounts along with advertising Galaxy fireworks provide. He suggested that all who have social medial should share any information on their personal pages. Shifts were discussed that they should be shorter verses longer so the volunteers won't get burned out and that more would consider volunteering.

Amy Magruder joined the group and discussed the end of the fiscal year, which is 06.30.2020 and what must be done before Mrs. Rodgers exit her position such has adding and removing names from the bank accounts. There was a concern that ALL executive committee positions have not been filled yet (Vice President-*the Pit Crew boss* and Fundraiser officer II) and must try to get those filled before the official vote before school starts in the fall.

Discussion continued of the Galaxy firework store involved more detail of the training session, which will be Saturday, 06.20.2020 at 1pm. Items to be discussed would be proper behavior for the volunteers, usage of face masks, T-shirts/dress code and the new implantation of on-line orders/curbside delivery. It was noted that due to curbside delivery the break room will be used to store orders and the students will have a temporary breakroom outside under a tent where coolers, and chairs will be provided but students are encouraged to bring a jug of water to drink.

Mr. Christian noted that due to props being used for the 2020 Marching Band show, and additional U-Haul trucks will be need. As of now, the district will pay for a rental of truck from a designated place, which is 45 minutes away or the boosters can pay for a local truck. Mr. Christian noted that the goal is for the district to pay for transportation and to have an 18-wheeler by the 21-22 school year. Additional information will be provided

after Mr. Christian discuss the issue with Michael Ouellette of the Fine Arts department of KatyISD.
